"Vivian said I got chills, I couldn't believe I have never seen anybody this age do this kind of thing," Mother of Max & Louis; Heidi Ma stated.

Where Louis has a specialty drawing or painting flowers...

"Louis can see a flower once in his life or a field and it comes right out," said Dwyer.

Max...visualizes more abstract art like bugs and animals.

"It really makes me, it really makes me happy," Max Boyang mentioned with a big grin across his face.

Locals enjoy the brothers' art so much that the twins decided to host an art show.

"They started coming twice a week at night and they have this fabulous show with about 40 pieces," Dwyer stated.

Whether they're selling pictures of bumblebees or sunflowers, what makes this show so special is that all money raised goes towards cancer research.

"We're giving all of it to the Joey's Wings Child Cancer Foundation," said Louis Boyang.

"We're doing a silent auction...whatever they can give, they'll give," Dwyer mentioned.

The twins don't have a number in mind, but they do hope their intricate artwork will help change the lives of those who need it the most.

"It's a gift they're born with it and they're both absolutely amazing," said Dwyer.
